Ps 42:1,2 As the deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul for you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.

John 4:23,24 But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship Him, God is spirit and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth. (ESV)

Did you know the Father is seeking you? I wouldn't necessarily say He needs us, but He does want us to love Him and worship Him. I've long said to know God is to worship Him. Psalms 29:2 Give the Lord the glory due His name: Worship the Lord in the splendor of His holiness. Psa. 100:4 Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise, Give thanks to Him and praise His name. Psalms 101:1 I will sing of faithful love and justice. I will sing praise to You, Lord. Psalms 103:1 Bless the Lord O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name

These verses speak of praising the Lord. Our lives should be a life of praise. Is yours? What we do and how we act should praise the Lord. This praising will indeed lead you to worship. True worship can only be experienced. When you begin to love God with all your heart, mind, soul and strength, there will be something deep within that longs to call out to the Spirit of God, to shower Him with everything you can think of that is good. Such immense thanksgiving, absolute adoration, luxurious love and powerful praise is due to our creator, who is worthy of all praise. Have you ever just stopped everything right where you're at and just begun to tell Him how much you love Him? Psalms 34:13-14 Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking deceit, Turn away from evil and do good, Seek peace and pursue it. (Also read I Peter 2:1-10)

I suppose, we wouldn't be in a lot of the predicaments we find ourselves in if we could follow these two verses. Thus, saving ourselves and others a world of hurt. Peter cites these Psalms in chapter 2, letting us know how the Lord will deliver us out of suffering if we truly have "tasted and seen that the Lord is good". We will move away from the ungodly hypocrisy so prevalent in today's world and will become "living stones" in God's spiritual house. Holy life is distinguished and observed by how you deal with others. Ideal behavior is letting Him be your peace. Choosing to turn away from the bad, whenever it shows itself, is the mark of a true Christian. Practice makes perfect.

Jude 20 But you beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit. Keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting for the mercy (undeserved forgiveness) that leads to eternal life

So, how do you build yourselves up in faith? What is your faith? It's the known and received body of truth about Jesus and salvation through Him! I Timothy 6:12 says; "Fight the good fight of faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses" II Timothy 4:7 says; I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Go for the crown! Be the best Christian you can be! Get out of the dungeon of despair! Let the world see your light! You are an overcomer! How is this possible? Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

That sounds like worship to me...and praise...and thanksgiving...and prayer. Those are all signs of the Christ centered life. They all go hand-in-hand. So, be persistent in prayer men of God. Ask God to surround you with His presence so that every word and deed you do is like His arm reaching out in love to those around you. His peace is one of the greatest feelings you can carry through any storm. Knowing He's got your back. And when the storm dissipates don't forget to thank Him.
