The explosive landmine of Compromise. The landmines of Disappointment or Unforgiveness. Fear! This and the next one are more like bombs in us men, Immorality! Ouch!!!

My nephew just did a tour of Iraq not long ago, thank God he's home safe and sound, and this ministry does pray and thank God for all of our veterans. I've heard experiences and have wondered what it might feel like to face the enemy in battle. In the heat of the battle the enemy will try to do anything to bring you down in defeat. After deciding to love God and try and serve Him, Satan has done his best to bring me down in defeat. Look where we're at gentlemen. He's pretty good at what he does. He wants us to get discouraged and give up. A disarmed warrior, fallen in the dust of defeat, crushed by guilt and shame is no serious threat. We've been in the landmine field a while now, but I've come this month to tell you he's improvised his armament. Well, I didn't want to have them run in to me, (you know I try to stay away from trouble), but as they were leaving the area where we were all at, I could feel them staring holes in me, they were burning me with their x-ray eyes, I guess I could feel it. Kryptonite was everywhere and I felt weak. I knew they had been told I was the trouble-maker. The one who had upset the apple cart of their precious little belief system. Their "put God in a religious box" had been exposed, they knew it, they were mad and they wanted me to know. The spiritual darts were flying! Or were they! This is what the Lord said: "You think you see what is going on – You "sort of" do, but let Me show you how the devil

improvises. "Ok, let's say you do see all those things in those people. Why would I let you see them?" He's right! I did know what I had discerned was absolutely correct, but it made me angry. The landmine had been seen but it had been improvised. I no more prayed for them than the man-in-the-moon. I was ticked off. How could I get even. Whoa! What? I was jealous of the jealous? I was angry at the angry? I didn't want to forgive? The enemy had improvised the explosive device and I was in pieces. "Dear God", I cried, "Help Me!?" He immediately said, "The enemy is currently improvising his tactics by attacking the believers more than ever before for My return is soon! Don't let the knowledge and discernment I give you allow you to get comfortable. You are in a battle my son. One larger than you could ever know in the natural." "Those family members you thought were mad-dogging you, they could care less about you or what you're about. Your own pride made you feel like that. I allowed their twisted faces and looks to reveal a little more about you to yourself because that's who you're supposed to be working on. You!" Me? "Yes, you!" Leave your enemies to me, vengeance truly is Mine!" "No weapon formed against you will prosper and every tongue that accuses you in judgment I will condemn.
