So...... how do you build up yourselves in faith? What is your faith? It's the known and received body of truth about Jesus and salvation through Him!

I Tim 6:12 says;

Fight the good fight of faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

11 Tim 4:7 says;

I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

Go for the crown! Be the best Christian you can be! Get out of the "mully grubs"! Let the world see your light! You are an overcomer! How is this possible? Only by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony which our faith is built on.

Romans 8: 26-28 says;

Eph. 6:18 tells us, after letting us know about putting on the armor of God, that the weapons for warfare are spiritual because they are rooted in prayer which is our most powerful resource. Prayer should permeate every fiber of our being and lay out the course for our lives, not to get what we want but that His will would be done at <u>all</u> times, with <u>all</u> prayer, with <u>all</u> perseverance, for all the saints.

This prayer is worship because it's in the Sprit, not in the flesh. It's enabled by the Sprit of God within you. By worshipping, you are walking in the Spirit and abiding in His mercies.

Col 3:15-17 says;

And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body, and be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom singing hymns, and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Sounds like worship to me, and praise, thanksgiving and prayer. These are all signs of the Christ-centered life. They all go hand-in-hand. So be persistent in prayer men of God. Be a prayer addict and kick the devil in the mouth. Remember Jesus' own words in Mark 14:38;

Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."

I'm pulling for you to rise up and be overcoming, powerful leaders for the Kingdom of God, not some "namby pamby", phony whiny unusable vessel. Find your place in the kingdom of warriors! Be bold! Be strong! For the Lord, your God is with you!
