Below is an excerpt from a letter from a former inmate named Efrnin Coronado. We at Chief Ministries became very fond of him because through some of the staff of Chief Ministries he came to know Jesus as his Lord and Savior and was also discipled.

He was a well-known gang member when he was put in prison. Efrain who was not killed by any gang members in prison, but he was killed after he was home and was attending a family barbeque. It is very serious to leave a gang once you have joined it and a person seldom leaves alive. We at Chief Ministries are still very sad about Efrain, but we know we will see him again in heaven someday.

Thank you for taking the time to write to me, and also for the card and the prayers.

You know now that I am out of the gang and moved into God. I feel a lot better. I am not afraid of these people because I know He is watching over me. I also got word from the leader of the gang that I was not going to be hurt, that they respected that I wanted out.

A lot of them want out too, so I'm trying to get them to go to church to start getting them to see their real leader.
