These and more are all legitimate questions, of course, but if you are who you say you are - a child of the King - you'll put your fear aside and let the love of your Father in Heaven cast out that fear. God is love and perfect love casts out fear. Philippians 4:6-7 says, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." God has given us everything we need to survive and even prosper if we remain obedient - that's the hard part when we don't want to surrender everything to Him. 2 Peter 1:3-4 says, "By His divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a Godly life. (Prov 3:5-6) I'm writing these things to you because I feel some of you have been feeling down about your time - it's precious - don't waste it! Can you imagine what would happen if we all took the time we waste here in prison and spend that time in prayer? "But Chief, I can't seem to concentrate, or pray that long!" Well, you're the guys I see spending a whole lot of your time reading nonsense or slammin' dominos or watching TV and concentrating on that for more than an hour a day! I'm guilty sometimes too, and that's why the Lord has me checking you for Him right now in this letter! We all need to prioritize a bit better and work at this Christian walk. "Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected, but I press-on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. (Phil 3:12) You see when we get sidetracked by nonsense, which is a trick of the enemy, we let our faith waiver, and anxiety and stress and even doubt moves in and becomes bigger than our faith! Well, PRESS ON! God knows what you're going through, He hears your prayers and he'll give you peace as you press on! No distrust in God makes us men of faith and unwavering concerning the promises of God, as we give glory to Him, we should be fully convinced that God is able to

do what He promised. That is why Abrahams' faith was counted unto him as righteousness and will be to us as well if we will believe!

Believe God will get you out of this mess when He's ready, when we've learned the lessons we are supposed to! Believe He'll restore unto you everything you've lost with greater things! Believe He'll re-unite you with those who will be good for your life in Him! Believe he has a perfect job for you! Believe He has the finances necessary for you to not only make it, but to prosper and be blessed to be a blessing!

Lift your head and arise and shine, for the glory of the Lord has risen upon you! He's surrounded you with His presence and power and is waiting for your faith to arise! Give Him the things pressing against you right now for He is able!

A prayer: My Father, you have my attention. Search me and remove the doubt and show Your purpose for me. I place all my fear and doubt at your feet. Crush them in your mighty hands and guide me into Your perfection! I believe all Your promises for me; in fact, I now can see how You have always had my best interests in Your mind. It was me who didn't see it. Open my eyes, Lord and help my heart understand You and what I must do to be the son and servant You want me to be. You are my blesser! You are my anointer! You are my healer and stress reliever! I thank you for all You are and all You have done for me and all You are going to do! I believe in You my God and King! Let Your peace fall into my life and over me and everything I'm involved in, including my family. And I thank- you and love You and Bless Your name. Amen....
